

## MOTORCYCLE COLLISION RECONSTRUCTION Course Originally scheduled for June 22 to 25, 2020 DUE TO COVID-19 RESCHEDULED TO: JUNE 7 TO JUNE 10, 2021

CATAIR Prairie Region is pleased to host a Motorcycle Collision Reconstruction Course that was initially scheduled for June 22nd through 25th in Edmonton, Alberta. Regrettably, due to the continued effects of COVID 19, and the resultant travel restrictions, CATAIR Prairie Region has decided to reschedule this event to a safer time, and is now re-scheduled for June 7 through June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

This ACTAR-accredited course is intended for intermediate to senior crash reconstruction professionals working in law enforcement or forensic engineering. The course will consist of three days of classroom instruction focused on various motorcycle topics such as collision statistics and reports, motorcycle dynamics, inspection methods, perception-response times, tire mark interpretation, swerves, acceleration, sliding friction, speed determination, vaults, Event Data Recorders, computer simulation analysis as well as Monte Carlo analysis.

Participants will be required to bring laptop computers with a current version of Microsoft Excel. The class will also include one day of motorcycle demonstrations to highlight specifics taught during the class. Class size will be limited to 35 participants and the class is approved for 32 CEUs by ACTAR.

The four-day course will be presented by Mr. Louis R. Peck, (former motorcycle road racer, Professional Engineer, collision reconstructionist and Principle at Lightpoint Scientific, LLC in Westlake Village, California). Please review Mr. Peck's resume as well as the outline for the custom designed course he has prepared for the occasion.
